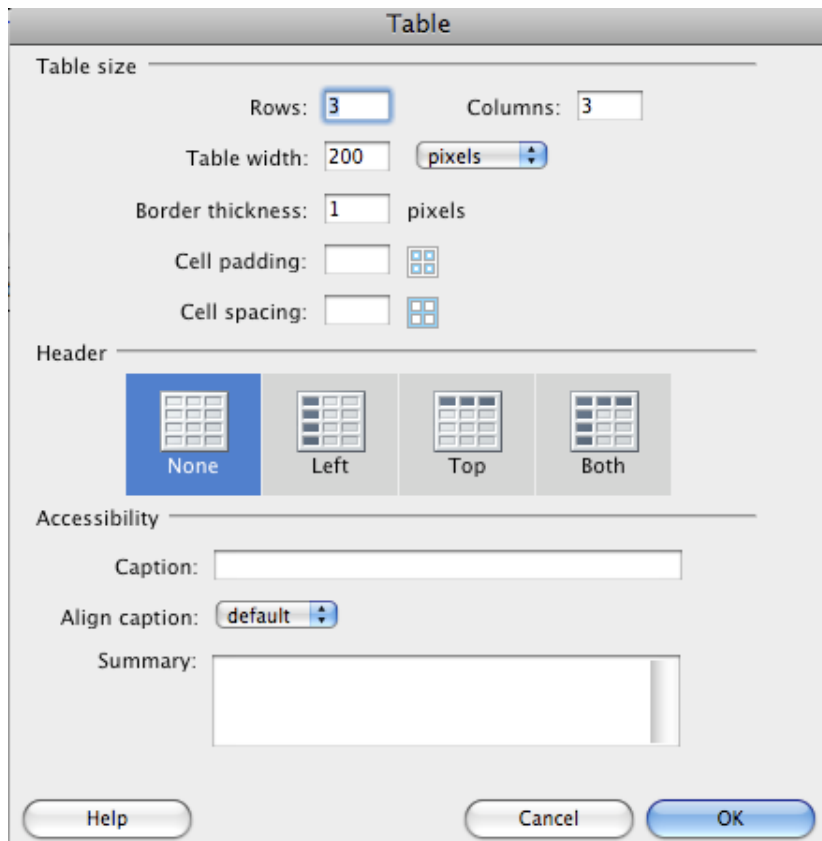


CREATING A TABLE IN DREAMWEAVER

Creating a Table

To create a table go to your toolbar and click *Insert > Table*

You will have a window open like this:



Choose your options and click OK.

Table Format

Row 1 Column 1	Row 1 Column 2	Row 1 Column 3
Row 2 Column 1	Row 2 Column 2	Row 2 Column 3
Row 3 Column 1	Row 3 Column 2	Row 3 Column 3
Row 4 Column 1	Row 4 Column 2	Row 4 Column 3

Page Layout Using Tables

Tables give a designer control over the positioning of images and text on the page.

Once you have created the design for your pages you can begin to build them using Dreamweaver. There are several factors that allow you to have the most control over content positioning and a consistent look for your site.

- Setting margin properties
- Centering the table on the page
- Setting border size
- Setting cell padding and cell spacing
- Setting table width

Web browsers add extra space around a table to offset it from the top and left side of the browser window. To display your table flush against the edge of the window, set the margin properties.

Choose **Modify > Page Properties**, then enter zero for each of the following fields:

Left Margin, Top Margin, Margin Width, Margin Height.

To center a table on the Web page, simply set the table alignment.

Select the table (not table cells) and use the **Property inspector** to set Align to Center.

To add a background image to a table, table column, or table cell:

- 1) In the **Document window**, select the table element to which you want to add a background image.
- 2) In the **Property inspector's BG field**, select the folder icon, then navigate to the image you want to use as the background image.
