Your letter of January 2nd, regarding the Cooley family came to this office. I am giving you what information I have been able to get.

*Aaron Henry* — A.H.Cooley died here in 1918. His widow lives on North Main Street, but is unable to give ~~us~~ *advice* much information about the Cooley family. A.H.Cooley's father was Aaron Cooley. Mrs.Nancy Anderson died about 1914. She has a son, Aca Anderson, who lives here, but with whom I have been unable to get in touch yet. Her daughter Mrs. Bett Yuille lives somewhere in Colorado. These are the only Cooleys living in the County so far as I can learn.

I have been unable as yet to run back any record of the land you mention, but will turn this over to A.F.Smith, County Recorder, who may be able to find the record.
