Cornelius + Polly (White) Cooley the latter a native of Mo.
Cornelius Cooley was a Kentuckian by birth. & settled
in Mo. when a young man and married there. Four
sons were born to Cornelius. When Mathias was but seven
years old the father (Cornelius) died & requested the lad be placed
in care of family named Wilson. In 1845 the Wilsons
crossed plains to far west. First settled at Dallas.
