Several deeds in the name of Henry Miller, with the following as wives: Christena, Ann Clara, Margaret, Catherane and Eleanor- probably one of these might be the right one, that is I thought maybe Eleanor might have been Eliz. of in other words, maybe a mistake.

Marriage in the name of Martin Cooley & Cath. Collins, 1798.

Deed in the name of John Cooley.

Jacob Miller Sr. was the founder of Woodstock, Va. He owned 2000 acres of land near Nrrrow Passage sometime before 1753. In 1761 Woodstock was laid out on his land.
