The March-April issue of Transit Postmark Collector, the award-winning journal of the Mobile Post Office Society, is in the mail to members.

In this issue, "News from the Cities" highlights a Special Delivery cover from member Rodney Juell that received the rare "Brooklyn & Coney Island" postmark and barely missed being dispatched on a departing ocean liner in Hoboken. The streetcar marking is the new last reported date of use of this cancellation.

Will Keller's "Highway Post Office" column features the Louisville & Saint Louis HPO.

22 newly-reported RPO markings are illustrated in color.

There is an update of the project to digitize MPOS literature, indicating that the set of 14 Streetcar RPO monographs plus a new publication about the Chattanooga Electric Car is nearly finished. Additionally, the Narrow-Gauge RPO catalog joins the US RPO catalog in current availability on CD-ROM, USB drive or through Dropbox. The US Route and Station Agent catalog is in progress.

The members-only mail bid sale contains 94 lots including literature and photographs from the David Gentry collection.
