Fair Requirements for 4-H Motorcycle

Enrolled in Self-Determined Mechanical Science Project “HC” by June 1st.

Required Papers on File: Medical Consent Release Form
 No Fault Form
 4-H Service and Repair Workshops Form
 Motorcycle/ATV Registration Certificate

Proof of Insurance (at least club insurance)

Must have attended:

- TWO County Rides and Ridden (one must be a Skills ride)
- TWO County Educational Events (Judging, Quiz Bowl, Maintenance Clinic, Speakers,)
- Participate in ONE Community Service Project
- Must attend 50% of your Club Meetings/Activities
- Meet your 4-H Club Fair Requirements
- Enter an Informational Poster at Fair
- Work 4 Hours in the Motorcycle Booth at Fair
- Must participate in Fitting & Showing to Ride in Skills

Keeping a Record Book or Calendar and doing a Demonstration is highly recommended but not required.

To participate in Motorcycle Riding activities the 4-H Member must be 3rd grade and age 8 by January 1st of current club year through age 18.

Motorcycle/ATV must be in safe running order and have a U.S. Forest Service approved spark-arrestor or a U.S.D.A. muffler.

Motorcycle/ATV must have a current ATV, ORV sticker or Street License. Both brakes and clutch will be in proper working order.

Required Riding Gear: helmet, gloves, goggles, jersey or long sleeved shirt, motorcycle pants or jeans (no sweat pants), motorcycle boots or leather lace-up boots over the ankle (no tennis shoes). Optional Gear: kidney belt, kneepads, chest protector, and elbow pads.

Tool Kit: sparkplug, sparkplug wrench, pliers, common screwdriver, vice grips, phillips screwdriver, master link, 6” crescent wrench, wire, duct tape, small piece of sandpaper or emery paper, several zip ties.
