I will ans your letter of

I am the youngest child
of William Jefferson Cooley.
I do not know much
about the family records
date's and let my mother
was Elizabeth Bryant
daughter of James and Nellie
Bryant. They had ten
children, seven are living
myself a Brockman married
Robertson first Brockman
second. there were six
children of the Robertson
marriage. all dead but
one, who is Mrs Louise
Early of Louisville Ky
My father had and
whole James that moved
to mo about 1825 or 26
and died there several years
later but I do not know his

date. The old bible that contained
 the records burned several
 years ago. my fathers
 bible hasnt any records
 except his own family
 I am going to visit
 one Ben Horious, that lives
 in this Co and see if he
 knows any thing that
 will be of any intrest
 he is a very old man
 the weather is so bad
 here that we do not travel
 about much, but will
 see him as soon as I can
 Wm Aron Cooley^m lived in the
 extreme northern part of
 Adair Co and died there. he and
 his wife died the same time
 and were ^{buried} at Palistine in
 Taylon Co, and the children
 were scattered, were all
 taken to Mo but W M Jefferson
 and Mary A.
 My father was raised by
 the Fisher family I know
 nothing of the family's of the

ones that were taken to Mo
 I believe with out a doubt
 your James Cooley, and the
 James Cooley that was my
 Father's uncle, was the same
 man. as my father
 uncle James went to Mo
 and that he he had
 some relation in
 Oregon

I will see the Horvicious
 man as soon as I can
 if you want any names
 and dates of any of the
 family; that I can, furnish
 will be glad to do so
